"Spaying and Neutering: Why? When? How?"

Dr. Bruce Christensen, DVM, MS, DACT will discuss why we should, or shouldn't, sterilize our dogs, when is the best time to do it with regard to age and breed and family dynamics, and the different types of sterilization protocols and procedures that are available and when each one might be appropriate.

Theriogenology is an exceedingly specialized field with fewer than 400 board-certified theriogenologists worldwide. Dr. Christensen is recognized for his clinical expertise and academic achievements. He received his DVM from Cornell University and his residency in theriogenology at the University of Florida in 2006 as well as a Master of Science degree in reproductive physiology.
