The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

NR1.08100.24000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years & under 9 years.

NR1.08100.36900. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 9 years & under 11 years.

NR1.08100.37200. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches 11 years & over.

*"Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches **may** be entered in Veteran Classes at a Specialty that does not offer classes beyond Best of Breed.*

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately or in another class. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog and his Get shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. If entered for Stud Dog Only, Regular Class fee will be charged for the Unit. The Stud Dog MUST be shown in the ring with his Get. Stud Dog only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

NR2.09300. Brace - Two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

80000. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

HARVEST MOON CLASSIC GROOMING GROOMING INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

THERE IS TO BE ABSOLUTELY NO TAPE PUT ON THE FLOOR OF ANY BUILDING. THERE WILL BE A \$250.00 FINE ASSESSED TO ANYONE FOUND DOING SO.

All reserved grooming will be inside. Electrical will be provided inside in all paid grooming spots. Extension cords will be necessary. Dogs and equipment may be left overnight in the buildings but you do so entirely at your own risk. Owners and/or handlers are responsible for their dogs left in the buildings. Any person leaving their dogs overnight must leave a sign in their space with your Name and Emergency Contact(s) information should any problems arise. The buildings will be locked at 8:00 PM and be opened at 6:00 AM. There will be no security provided. The board, officers and staff of WheresMySpace.com, the Sonoma County Fairgrounds, MBF, Inc., Del Valle Dog Club of Livermore and Skyline Dog Fanciers of San Mateo County assume no responsibility for dogs or equipment unattended or left in the buildings.

There are no ex-pens allowed in buildings other than Cocker Pens in Grace Pavilion with plastic underneath and shavings on top. These will be kept scrupulously clean at all times. Do not throw dirty water into trash barrels, bring a container for this. Remember to bring a broom to keep your space clean. The grooming buildings will be checked each night for cleanliness.

All generators must be 30 feet from any building, tent, ring or canopy.

Reserved grooming setup will start Wednesday after 3:00 P.M.; however, "your" space will be reserved for your arrival on any day of the cluster.

Some spaces may be irregular due to pillars/electrical drops.

DAY CRATING AREAS:

THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL MARK DAY CRATING SPACES. ALL ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE DAY CRATING AREAS BY THE END OF THE SHOW DAY. The Show Committee reserves the right to consolidate spaces to accommodate exhibitors.

USE OF DRYERS, ELECTRICAL HOOKUP, SCISSORING, BATHING OF DOGS OR OVERNIGHT SETUP IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE DAY CRATING AREAS OF THE MAIN SHOW BUILDING.

AISLES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR. The Show Committee will designate holding areas near the rings for exhibitors to put crates and tables and Dollies while they are showing. Only approved grooming space may be used for grooming.

NON-RESERVED GROOMING AREA: Although reservations are recommended, free grooming areas, without power are available outside the buildings in designated areas. Please bring your own shade. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
